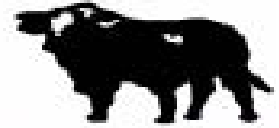

ANALYSIS

For the week, Chicago wheat closed \$.51 higher; Kansas City wheat \$.38 higher and Minneapolis wheat \$.17 1/4 higher. Last week, private exporters did not announce any private sales.

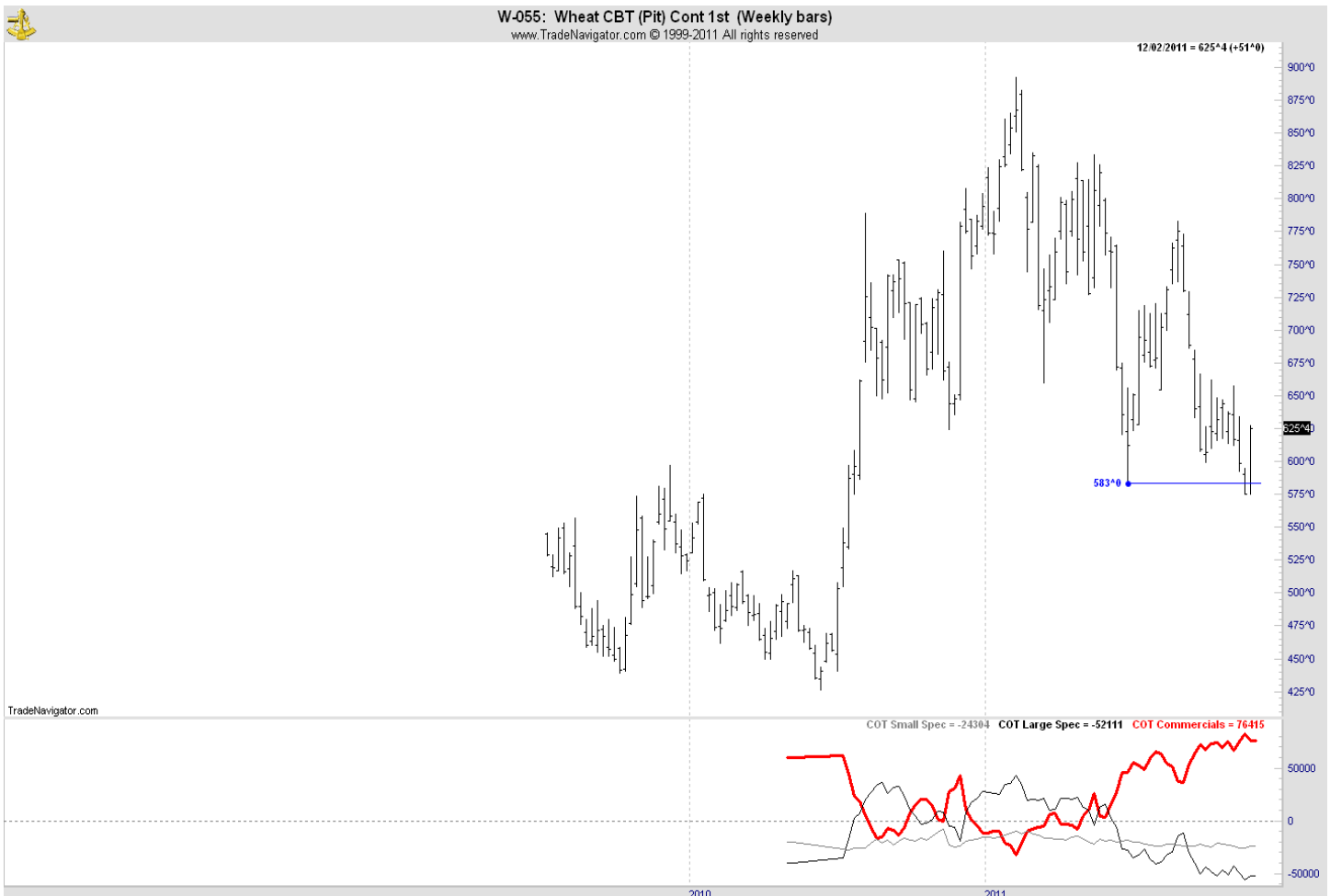
Last week's crop progress report showed winter wheat conditions were 2% improved from last week at 52% g/e, slightly better than last year's 47% g/e rating. Kansas is rated 47% g/e while Oklahoma is rated 56%, Texas is 25% and Nebraska is 74%.

Total US wheat sales over the last four weeks have totaled 64 million bushels, well below last year's strong sales of 117 mb.

STRATEGY & OUTLOOK

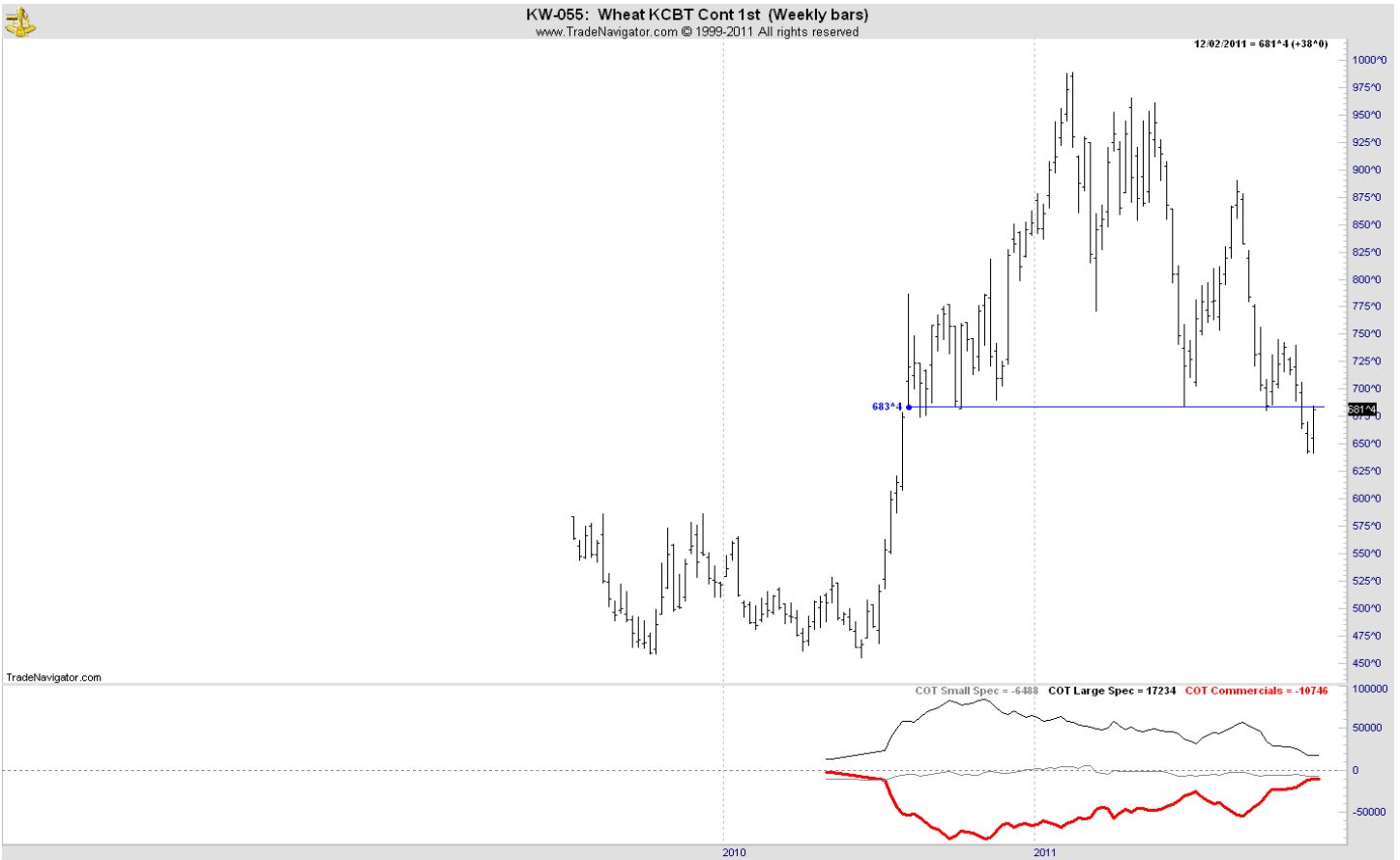
Producers are now 50% sold against the 2011 crop. We would advise another 20% sale for the 2011 crop at \$9.55 against the Kansas City contract against the weekly resistance and buy at the money puts.
